OREGON STATE HISTORY AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS



2015 NCAA Championships

The 2015 NCAA Championships took place April 17-19 at the Fort Worth Convention Center Arena. Six NCAA Regional Championships were held April 4 with each first and second place team advancing to the championship meet. Regionals were held on the campuses of: Auburn, California, Iowa State, Ohio State, Oklahoma, and West Virginia. Oregon State qualified to its 27th national championship appearances (24 NCAA, three AIAW) in 38 seasons.

OSU ALL-AMERICANS



HEIDI ANDERSON
1984 • 1985

Heidi earned All-America honors at both Penn State and Oregon State ... After transferring to Oregon State, she added three more All-American honors as a Beaver winning the national title on the beam in 1984 ... Added her fourth and fifth All-American accolades on beam and all-around in 1985 ... Won the 1981 AIAW national title on the floor exercise and was a three-time NCAA All-American at Penn State before transferring to OSU in Sept. 1982.



MARILYN ANDERSON
1993

Marilyn became a second-team All-American on beam at the 1993 NCAA Championships in Corvallis as a sophomore ... Tied for 15th with a score of 9.75, which marked a career-best ... As an all-rounder, actually averaged higher on the other three events that season but peaked on beam at nationals.



ERIKA AUFIERO
2015

Erika earned All-America First Team on the uneven bars scoring a 9.900 during the evening semifinal session ... recorded a 9.8250 on bars at Event Finals to finish 11th overall.



MARY AYOTTE-LAW
1981 • 1982

Mary earned AIAW All-America status on beam, floor and all-around in 1981 ... Became the second OSU gymnast in history to win a national championship (the first year OSU competed in the NCAA) with a title on the floor exercise ... She added NCAA All-America honors with a third place finish in the all-around ... In all, she was a five-time All-American.



TINA BARNES
1985 • 1986

Tina became Oregon State's fifth All-American in 1985 when she placed fourth on vault at the NCAA Championships ... Earned repeat All-America honors in 1988 with a seventh-place finish on vault.




HEATHER BENNETT
1995 • 1996

Heather earned first team All-America honors twice on the uneven bars ... As a junior, tied for third (9.90) to qualify for the individual finals ... Placed 10th in the finals with a 9.225 after suffering a fall from a broken grip ... As a senior, she scored a 9.95 to earn first team honors ... Placed second in the individual finals that year.



KELSI BLALOCK
2013

Kelsi earned NACGC/W Regular Season All-American honors on the vault in 2013 after ranking sixth in the nation during the regular season with an RQS of 9.930.



LAURIE CARTER
1981 • 1983 • 1984

Laurie distinguished herself as OSU's first national champion when she claimed the title on beam in 1981 ... Went on to capture additional All-America honors on beam in 1983 and 1984 ... Placed fifth in '83 and was eighth in '84.


LAURA-ANN CHONG 2010

Laura-Ann became a second-team All-American on the uneven bars and balance beam at the 2010 NCAA Championships as a senior ... Tied for seventh on both events with scores of 9.85.




TRACI CROVER 1992 • 1993 • 1994

One of only six OSU gymnasts to earn All-America status in three or more events, Traci became a five-time All-American her senior year (1994) ... Earned first team honors on beam in '94, placing fourth in the finals ... As a junior, captured first team honors with a fifth-place finish in the beam finals and earned second team recognition with a 14th-place finish on floor ... In '92, was a second team All-American on both bars and beam ... Tied for ninth on bars and 12th on beam with scores of 9.825 and 9.725, respectively ... Her ninth-place finish on bars was one place shy of making the individual finals and a first team All-America mention.



LARA DEGENHARDT 2000 • 2001

Lara became a two-time All-American as a senior when she earned first team recognition on vault, placing sixth in event finals with an average of 9.775 on her two vaults ... Scored a 9.90 in prelims to earn a spot in the finals ... She earned second team All-America honors on floor as a junior in 2000 ... Tied teammate Tanya Riccioli with a score of 9.85 in the afternoon preliminary competition to place seventh in that session.



DEANNE DROEGEMUELLER 1995 • 1998

Deanne became a two-time All-American after earning first team honors on bars as a senior in 1998 ... Scored a 9.90 on her routine to earn first team All-American status but did not advance to finals ... As a freshman, Deanne was a first team All-American on beam ... tied for eighth with a score of 9.825 ... In the individual finals, took 12th place (9.325).



AMY DURHAM 1992 • 1993

One of two OSU gymnasts to earn All-American status in four different events ... In her final season (1993), Amy became a five-time All-American after earning first team honors on all-around and floor and second team honors on vault ... Placed fourth all-around with a career high 39.30 and won the national title on floor with a perfect 10.0 ... Scored a 9.85 on vault to take ninth place ... As a junior, earned second team All-America status on vault and bars ... Tied for 12th on vault (9.80) and 16th on bars (9.80) at the NCAA Championships in Minnesota.



MADELINE GARDINER 2014 • 2015 • 2016

Madeline earned first team All-American honors on the balance beam and in the all-around as a freshman in 2014 scoring 9.90 on the beam in the afternoon session of semi-finals to tie for second and advance to event finals ... scored 9.8875 in Event Finals to tie for third in the nation on the beam ... scored 39.225 to tie for fourth in her session in the all-around ... in 2015, earned first team All-America on beam with a 9.90 in semifinals ... scored 9.9250 in Event Finals to finish third overall ... earned NACGC/W Regular Season Second Team All-American in 2016.



ELIZABETH JILLSON 2002

Elizabeth earned first team All-American honors on bars as a junior ... Scored a 9.85 in the evening session preliminaries to tie for fourth place and advance to finals ... Tied for 11th with a 9.788 in event finals.



MELANIE JONES 2012

Melanie scored 9.875 on the floor exercise to qualify for Individual Event Finals and earned first team All-American honors for the first time as a junior in 2012 ... She went on to score 9.925 in event finals to tie for fourth - the highest finish on floor for the Beavers since 1993.

JEN KESLER
2008 • 2009 • 2011

Jen earned first team All-America status for the first time in her career as a senior. She scored 9.90 to tie for top honors in the semifinal and scored 9.875 in event finals to finish second overall in 2011 ... She earned second team All-American status in each of her first two seasons at OSU ... In 2008, she scored a 9.900 in the preliminary competition to tie for fifth in the session ... In 2009, she scored 9.850 in the preliminary round to tie for seventh.




CHARI KNIGHT
1991 • 1992 • 1994

A seven-time All-American, Chari is one of two Beavers with All-American honors in four different events ... As a freshman in 1991, she tied for second on bars and placed fifth in the all-around and third on beam at the NCAA Championships ... Her second place finish on bars ties for the best ever by an OSU gymnast ... As a sophomore, she tied for fifth on floor for her fourth All-America honor ... Became a seven-time All-American as a senior in 1994 when she was first team on beam and floor and second team in the all-around ... Placed fourth on beam and ninth on floor in the finals ... Missed the 1993 Championships with a knee injury.



YUKI LAMB
2008

Yuki scored 9.875 on the vault to qualify for individual finals and earn first team All-American honors as a senior ... Her mark tied for third during the preliminary competition ... She scored 9.7375 to finish seventh in the event finals ... She earned a score of 9.8875 on her first vault, which was the fifth highest score of the day.



CHRISSY LAMUN
2006

Chrissy earned second team All-American status on balance beam as a senior ... She scored a 9.825 in the preliminary session to tie for eighth in the session.




JAMI LANZ
2007 • 2008 • 2009

Jami was truly a great all-around competitor for the Beavers competing in the all-around in every meet of her career - 56 meets. She earned second team All-American status three times during her career; once on vault, once on uneven bars and once on the balance beam ... In 2007, she scored a 9.850 on bars in the team competition to tie for eighth in the session ... In 2008, she scored 9.825 on the beam during the preliminaries to tie for sixth ... In 2009, she scored a 9.90 on the vault during preliminary round to tie for fifth.



LESLIE MAK
2011

Leslie earned first team All-America honors as a junior in the all-around and on the balance beam. She scored 39.350 in the Beavers' semifinal session to tie for third in the session and seventh overall ... She added a 9.875 on the beam to finish second in the session and advanced to Individual Event Finals where she ended up 10th ... Leslie wrapped up her career with a pair of second team honors on beam and floor exercise in 2012.



KAYTIANNA McMILLAN
2016

Kaytianna received NACGC/W Regular Season First Team All-America accolades on uneven bars in 2016 ... She finished the regular season ranked No. 7 in the nation on the apparatus to earn her honors.



RÄNDI MILLER
1995 • 1996

Rändi claimed All-America honors twice on balance beam ... In '95, she was a first team recipient, scoring a 9.90 to tie for second place in the preliminaries and then scoring a 9.80 to place 10th in the individual finals ... As a junior ('96), she scored a 9.775 for second team honors.



OSU ALL-AMERICANS



MEGAN MURPHY 1996

Megan became a first team All-American on beam her freshman season ... Took fifth place in the individual finals with a 9.875 ... Tied for eighth (9.825) to qualify for finals.



LINDA PARKER 1978 • 1980

Linda was the second OSU gymnast to earn All-America status ... Claimed All-America honors on floor exercise in '78 and balance beam in '80 ... Placed fourth on floor and seventh on beam at the NCAA Championships.



TANYA RICCIOLI 2000

Tanya earned second team honors on floor as a freshman after scoring a 9.85 in the afternoon session of the preliminary competition ... With the All-American status as a rookie in 2000, Tanya became the first OSU freshman in four years to earn All-America honors.



MANDI RODRIGUEZ 2007 • 2009 • 2010

Mandi finished her career as a seven-time All-American, including four first team honors ... Finished a career-best third place on the vault at Event Finals with a 9.8438 in 2010 ... In 2007 she finished fifth overall on vault with a score of 9.8375 ... In 2009, she also earned first team honors on vault and floor exercise finishing seventh and tied for sixth respectively. She also scored 39.40 in the all-around to earn second team.



RENEE RUNYON 1994 • 1995

Renee earned her first All-America accolade as a sophomore, with a first team showing on bars in 1994 ... Tied for seventh in the team competition with a season-high score of 9.85 ... In the finals, took 10th with a 9.20 ... Earned second team All-America honors on the same event a year later with a score of 9.825 to tie for 12th place.



MICHELLE SANDOZ 1993

Michelle became a first team All-American on beam in 1993 as a junior ... Scored a 9.70 to place eighth in the NCAA individual finals ... Advanced to the finals after placing fourth in the team competition with a 9.825.



JOY SELIG 1988 • 1989 • 1990 • 1991

Joy has more first team All-America accolades to her name than any other OSU gymnast ... Became a seven-time All-American as a senior in 1991 when she finished seventh all-around and third on floor at the NCAA Championships ... Earned her first All-America honor as a freshman as the national runner-up on floor ... As a sophomore, she claimed the national championship on beam and place fourth on floor ... Won her second NCAA beam title in 1990 and won her first national title on floor that same year.



KATRINA SEVERIN 2000 • 2001

Katrina was honored as a first team All-American on vault as a senior when she finished as the national runner-up with a 9.8687 average on her two vaults ... Her finish was the best ever by a Beaver vaulter ... Had the highest score (9.95) of any vaulter in the preliminary session ... Earned All-American honors for the first time as a junior in 2000 when she received second team honors on beam with a 9.80 in the preliminary competition.



OSU ALL-AMERICANS



JAMI SHERMAN
1988

Jami earned All-America honors as a freshman walk-on in 1988 ... After averaging 9.46 on vault during the season, she responded to the pressure of nationals with two solid vaults that earned her a fifth-place finish in the individual finals ... Became a scholarship athlete the following year and completed her final season in 1991.




AMY SLACK
1995

Amy earned second team All-America honors on beam as a freshman ... Tied with teammate Amanda Turko for 14th place with a score of 9.80.



TASHA SMITH
2006 • 2007 • 2009

Tasha was an All-American three times during her career at OSU ... In 2006, she became a second team All-American on vault as a freshman when she tied for fifth in the preliminary session with a score of 9.85 to earn a spot on the second team ... In 2007, Tasha earned first team honors on vault. She nailed her first vault posting one of the highest scores of the day, but fell on the second to finish 11th overall ... In 2009, she scored 9.85 on the floor to tie for sixth in the preliminary round and earned second team status.



WENDY SMITH
1992

Wendy became an All-American in 1992, her sophomore season ... She qualified for the individual event finals on vault at the NCAA Championships by tying for fifth with a career-best score of 9.85 ... Finished 10th in the finals but performed one vault rather than two different ones to avoid further knee damage after hyperextending her knee on vault in the final dual meet of the season.




KRISTIE SNYDER
1995

Kristie earned All-America accolades with a second team honor on vault in 1995 ... Tied for 10th place with a 9.90.



DONNA SOUTHWICK
1977

Donna became OSU's first All-American when she earned All-America status on bars at the 1977 AIAW National Championships ... 



Legendary Gill Coliseum was also the site of the 1990, 1993 and 2006 championships. OREGON STATE GREATS

OREGON STATE UNIVERSITY SPORTS HALL OF FAME

Seven Oregon State gymnasts are among the honorees who have been inducted into the Oregon State University Sports Hall of Fame. Following are brief bios on the gymnastics inductees, with the year inducted in parentheses.

HEIDI ANDERSON (2015)

Heidi earned three All-America accolades in her two seasons at Oregon State making her a six-time All-American at the conclusion of her career. She arrived in Corvallis as the 1981 AIAW national champion on the floor exercise and a three-time All-American at Penn State before transferring to OSU in Sept. 1982. Anderson lettered for the Beavers in 1984 and '85 garnering a trio of All-America honors in her short stay. In 1984, she was the national champion on the beam and followed that with a third place finish on the same event the following year. She added All-America honors in the all-around in 1985 giving her six for her career. A business major, she garnered CoSIDA Academic All-American honors in 1984.

MARY AYOTTE-LAW (1993)

Mary lettered at OSU from 1979-82. She earned All-American status in 1981 on the balance beam and in 1982 on floor exercise and all-around. She won the national championship in 1982 on floor and finished third in the all-around, the highest ever by a Beaver. She also finished seventh in the all-around in 1981. She won the regional all-around title all four years. Ayotte-Law concluded her OSU career with seven top-10 finishes at Nationals and held three school records. She was honored with the American Award for Athletic and Academic Performance. She represented the United States in 1981 at the World University Games in Romania, where she was the highest all-around competitor. She was named the team's most outstanding gymnast three times and the Corvallis Gazette-Times' Outstanding Gymnast three times.

LAURIE CARTER (1994)

Laurie was a four-year letterwinner from 1981-1984. She distinguished herself as OSU's first-ever national champion by winning the balance beam competition in 1981. Carter went on to earn All-American status on the beam in 1983 and 1984 by placing in the top eight each year. She earned three Regional titles on the beam and set a then-NCAA record of 9.90 on the beam in 1983. She helped OSU to a record of 79-24-1 in her time as a Beaver. During her tenure OSU finished in the Top-10 nationally three times.

TRACI CROVER (2005)

Traci Crover was one of only six gymnasts in Oregon State history to earn All-American status on three-plus events at the time of her induction. In all, she earned All-American status five times. Crover lettered from 1991-94 and helped the program to a combined record of 57-12. She helped the Beavers win three Pac-10 Conference titles, the 1991 and '92 Regional Championships, and finish in the top seven of the NCAA Championships all four of her years. She earned All-Pac-10 Conference honors twice. Crover was the co-Regional champion on the beam as a junior and earned All-America honors on the beam, bars and floor. Crover was also a standout in the classroom where she was named a CoSIDA Academic All-American as a senior and was a four-time National Association of Collegiate Gymnastics Coaches Scholastic All-American.

AMERICAN AWARD WINNERS

Three Oregon State gymnasts have earned the American Award, which honors the nation's top senior gymnast. The American Award is based on a gymnast's career academic and athletic achievements and is voted on by collegiate coaches across the nation. The award began in 1982, with Oregon State's Mary Ayotte becoming the first recipient of the prestigious honor. Joy Selig became OSU's second American Award winner in 1991, and Chari Knight received the award in 1994.

AMY DURHAM (2004)

Amy Durham lettered in gymnastics from 1990-93 and at the time of her enshrinement in 2004 was one of only two Beavers to earn All-America honors in four events. As a senior, Durham won the NCAA national title in the floor exercise by scoring a perfect 10.0. She also earned first-team All-America honors as a senior in the all-around and second team All-America acclaim on vault twice and on bars as a junior. Durham helped OSU win a pair of Pacific-10 and NCAA West Regional titles, and she propelled the Beavers to finish in the top seven at the NCAA Championships each of her four years. She also competed in the 1991 World University Games. In addition to her athletic accomplishments, Durham earned Academic All-America honors as a senior.

CHARI KNIGHT (2003)

Chari Knight is one of the most decorated gymnasts in OSU history. The seven-time All-American is one of only two individuals in school history to earn All-American honors in four events. Knight earned regional titles three times in all-around, twice on floor and beam, and once on bars and vault. She also was a two-time Pacific-10 Conference Gymnast of the Year. As a freshman, she matched the school record by finishing second on bars at the NCAA Championships. Knight scored a perfect 10 eight times during her collegiate career, including five times on bars. At the time of her induction, Knight was still actively competing and had participated in the last two U.S. Championships. She was a member of the 2000 U.S. Olympic Team selection committee.

LINDA PARKER (1992)

The second Oregon State gymnast to earn All-American status, Linda claimed her honors on floor exercise (placing fourth) in 1978 and balance beam (placing sixth) in 1980. She was also a three-time member of the All-Western Region Team. While at OSU, Parker led her team to two fourth-place finishes (1980 and '82) at the National Championships and three regional titles. Parker lettered four years.

JOY SELIG (1997)

Joy Selig lettered from 1988-91 and was a seven-time All-American. She earned the NCAA title on the balance beam twice and once on floor exercise. She was named to the Pacific-10 Conference Women's All-Decade Team in 1995 (all sports). She was the 1991 American Award recipient, an honor given to the nation's top gymnast. Selig was also an Academic All-American. At the time of her graduation, she held the school record in the all-around, balance beam, and floor exercise. She was the NCAA Woman of the Year for Oregon and participated in the World University Games in 1991.

WORLD UNIVERSITY GAMES

Five former OSU athletes - Mary Ayotte, Amy Durham, Chari Knight, Megan Murphy-Barcroft and Joy Selig - and former head coach Jim Turpin have taken part in the World University games. Turpin headed the silver-medal U.S. team at the 1991 Games, with Selig, Knight and Durham on his team. Knight won a bronze medal on bars that year. Ayotte was a member of the 1981 team. Murphy-Barcroft was named to the 1999 team, but was injured in Spain prior to the meet and did not compete.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

The Oregon State gymnastics program has long prided itself on top performances both on the competition floor as well as in the classroom.

Since 1984, OSU gymnasts have earned 99 Scholastic All-America honors from the National Association of Collegiate Gymnastics Coaches. In 2011, three OSU gymnasts earned the honors; Leilani Alferos, Leslie Mak and Stephanie McGregor.

Additionally, the same threesome was selected to the Pacific-10 Conference's All-Academic team in 2011. McGregor earned a spot on the first team while Alferos and Mak received second team status.

Seven Beaver gymnasts have also earned CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America mention throughout the course of the program. Most recently, Yuki Lamb was awarded the academic honor in 2008.

In 1991, the gymnastics team boasted the top grade point average of any team or by any particular sport in the nation (3.61 GPA). That year, nine OSU gymnasts earned NACGC Scholastic All-America accolades, and Joy Selig was a CoSIDA/GTE Academic All-American.

In 1992, OSU again had the top grade point average among all collegiate women's gymnastics teams (3.385 GPA), giving them the distinction at the time as the only team to earn the national academic title twice. From those teams, Kelly Baker, Traci Crover, Chari Knight, Donna Linder and Anne Marie Vassallo were all NACGC Academic All-Americans each of their four seasons.

Knight was also a CoSIDA Academic All-American in 1992 and 1994, and Crover earned CoSIDA recognition in 1994.

Heidi Anderson (1984), Amy Durham (1993) and Rändi Miller (1997) have also earned CoSIDA Academic All-America honors.

In 2008, Yuki Lamb became the seventh OSU gymnast to earn CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America honors.


